Support New Mexico's Non-Game Wildlife!

Do you enjoy watching wildlife and exploring new, wildlife-friendly areas? Are you interested in helping New Mexico's wildlife? If so, please consider supporting the **Share with Wildlife** program and purchasing a **Habitat Management Access Validation (HMAV)** today.

The mission of the Share with Wildlife program at the New Mexico Department of Wildlife (NMDOW) is to help those species that do not receive funding from any other source. The program funds wildlife-focused **research, habitat enhancement, education, and rehabilitation** activities all around New Mexico. In the past decade, the Share with Wildlife program has funded more than a hundred projects and distributed over 2.4 million dollars to support New Mexico's wildlife. These projects include **habitat enhancement** for species of conservation concern and **research** on their population distributions and ecology; **educational programs** that give K-12 students hands-on experience in collecting and analyzing scientific data in the field; and **wildlife rehabilitation facilities** that provide veterinary care for sick and injured native wildlife. Share with Wildlife depends on **tax-deductible** donations from the public. **All** donations support wildlife projects and no donated funds are used for program administration.

A HMAV will get you access to New Mexico State Wildlife Commission-owned or controlled lands to enjoy an abundance of outdoor recreation and wildlife-viewing opportunities. These lands include Wildlife Management Areas (WMAs) and are managed by NMDOW for the benefit of fish, wildlife, and their habitats (see more details [here](https://wildlife.dgf.nm.gov/conservation/state-game-commission-lands/) or at <https://wildlife.dgf.nm.gov/conservation/state-game-commission-lands/>). Your HMAV fee will go towards future habitat enhancement activities on these properties – to date, hundreds of thousands of dollars in HMAV fees have gone to conserve aquatic, riparian, and upland habitats for fish and wildlife throughout New Mexico.

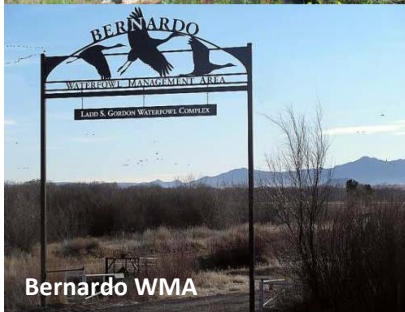
