- No Merchant Fees

- No chance of a lost or stolen license
- System sells customer-appropriate licenses
- No end of month reconciliation
- No shipping fees
- No special equipment
- No special security measures
- Future ability to sell all Department licenses

## License buyers benefits

- Accurate data capture
- Customer purchase history
- Wider selection of licenses types to purchase locally
- Prevents erroneous duplicate purchases
- Sold appropriate license from vendor
- Accept credit cards or checks
- Future assistance with Draw Applications

# Web-based Sales System

## Multiple benefits for the Department

- Capture accurate license information
- Link to the law enforcement revocation and parental responsibility act listings
- Linked to hunter harvest reporting system for all license sales
- Immediate revenue recognition
- Management of paper system is eliminated; saves on production and data entry costs
- Allows more local businesses to become vendors
- Saves Department manpower and fiscal resources

# Web-based Sales System

## Business processes that need to be addressed

- How to handle voided licenses
- Because system is web-based, the collection of cash for payment is an issue
- Payment of the \$1 vendor fee/license document to vendors; payment will happen but payment process needs to be identified
- Elimination of specialized carcass tag
- Validation of license information
- Use of “card readers” to collect license buyer any payment information

# Web-based Sales System

Survey of the current 177 vendors:

- 152 vendors want to move to the web-based sales system. The main reasons for the support were: system would allow them to be more accurate, save time in monthly reconciliation, save time in issuing licenses and overall is a past-due development.
- 15 vendors like the idea but won't remain a vendor if there are higher costs associated with the new system.
- 10 vendors will not participate for two main reasons: not computer-savvy or there are internet connectivity issues.
