Reserving Two Elk Licenses for Non-Profit Wish-Granting Organizations



Field Operations Division

- 17-3-13.5 NMSA 1978 directs the State Game Commission to reserve no more than two elk licenses a year for persons under the age of 21 who have been determined by a physician to have a life-threatening illness and who have been qualified through a nonprofit wish-granting organization.



Wish Granting Organizations

There are 4 approved Non-profit Organizations

- **Hunt of a Lifetime (2013 cooperator)**
- **SafariWish (2013 cooperator)**
- **Catch-A-Dream (2012 cooperator)**
- **Outdoor Dream Foundation (2012 cooperator)**

Each organization selects their own applicants

Applicants must purchase an elk hunting license



Field Operations Division

Department Recommendation

- September 1, 2013 through December 31, 2013
- Any legal weapon type
- Any area open to elk hunting
- Either sex [ES] bag limit
