The Department will present a review of the current tagging requirements for big game and turkey, including the limitations and concerns it presents. At a future meeting the Department will provide options for addressing those issues.



With the advent of On-line Licensing, concerns have been raised by sportsmen about the lack of a carcass tag and about the potential for violators to exceed the legal bag limit.

Historically, a hunter would affix a carcass tag to a big game species or turkey immediately after harvest. Under the present system, the hunter invalidates his license when he has taken an animal, but there is no dept. issued carcass tag.



The Department is studying a number of possible options to address these concerns.
