Public Comment on Proposed Changes

72 attendees at 4 public meetings

57 written/emailed comments

- New Hunts (11)
- License adjustments (19)
- Split Archery Season (16)
- Thanksgiving Youth Hunt (7)
- Draw process (10)
- Other/unrelated (34)

Proposed Changes

- Adjust seasons for calendar dates
- Adjust draw license numbers based on biological data & management goals
- Create some new hunting opportunities
- Separate archery season into September & January (2 different seasons)
- Standardize most youth hunts to a 9 day hunt surrounding Thanksgiving week

NE Area Proposed Adjustments



- Allow ES white-tailed deer hunting for all white-tailed deer hunts
- Create new archery hunts: Valle Vidal and Colin Neblett
- GMU 56: Create ESWTD youth hunt
- GMU 41: Create new January archery hunt
- Increase licenses based on biological data

SE Area Proposed Adjustments

- GMU 30: Split rifle hunts evenly (800/hunt)
- GMU 31/33: Decrease youth licenses on Huey*
 - From 2 hunts of 20 to 2 hunts of 10 licenses
- GMU 34: Move muzzleloader hunt into November
- Increase licenses based on biological data



SW Area Proposed Adjustments

- GMU 19: Create any-legal-weapon on WSMR, move off-range hunt to first weekend in December
- <u>License Reductions</u>: GMU 23 (13%), GMU 23 Burros (13%)
 GMU 24 (10%)
- GMU 23 (Burros):
 - Decrease to 1 any-legal-weapon hunt; lengthen to 9 days
 - Create September white-tailed deer archery hunt
- Allow Burros archery hunters to hunt Silver City Management Area
- Move January FAWTD archery hunt to January 16-31
- Other license decreases based on biological data

NW Area Proposed Adjustments

- **GMU 4**:
 - Include Sargent in draw for WMAs
 - Create limited public and private hunt in late November
 - Create September archery hunt for WMAs
- GMU 5A: Create late September muzzleloader hunt
- GMU 5B: Create September archery hunt and late September muzzleloader hunt
- GMU 12: Move muzzleloader hunt into November
- **GMU 14**: Create January archery hunt
- License adjustments based on biological data

- Statewide 36,220 licenses sold/converted
- 88% of hunters reported
- 35% successful in harvesting
- Estimated statewide harvest
 - Bucks = 11,220; Does = 96
- Satisfaction rating = 3.4
