

- Committee review of GAIN program



19.34.3 Rule Change History

- Committee Goal: Adapt GAIN program/Rule to:
 - Facilitate the public going outdoors
 - Simplify and standardize Wildlife Management Area (WMA) access rules
 - Assist in economic development of communities near WMAs
 - Make sure access doesn't:
 - Negatively impact wildlife resources
 - Violate purpose of the property

Current Access of WMAs



- Fishing or hunting license, or GAIN permit is required to access WMAs
- GAIN allows non-consumptive users to access WMAs for outdoor recreation
- Access is very restricted and Department has taken the "WMAs are closed unless otherwise open" approach
- Only a few activities are allowed and access is not consistent between WMAs



- WMAs are open unless otherwise closed
- Eliminate GAIN permit
- Individual access with hunting, fishing, trapping and/or HMAV
- No license or stamp is required for youth to access (younger than 18 years of age)
- Group Access:
 - Group = up to 4 adults
 - One hunting, fishing or trapping license, and/or HMAV required per group



- Lands closed to general access during designated big game hunting seasons
 - Scouting allowed 7 days prior to hunt period
- Hunter and up to 3 guests exempt from closures during hunt and scouting period
- Camping limit increased to 14 days

Add rules for specific Properties to 19.34.3

- Rules for specific lands can include:
 - Camping prohibitions
 - Closure dates to protect wildlife and meet designated property purpose (elk calving, deer fawning, wintering dates)
 - Special activity allowance (snowmobile area on Edward Sargent WMA)

Public Comment

Public meetings (attendance): Abiquiu(8), Taos(1), Roswell(3), Silver City(5)

33 comments received as of April 11, 2016:

- Support proposed GAIN changes (11)
- Opposed to a ban on antler hunting (11) (not currently proposed)
- Opposed to any further restrictions/costs (2)
- Existing winter closure dates on Rio Chama WMA too long (6) (critical deer winter range)
- Support increased fishing access on Rio Chama WMA (3)

Rules specific to the Rio Chama WMA:

- All portions outside designated area closed November 15 through May 10 (Deer Wintering)
 (currently Nov 15 – Memorial Day weekend)
- Designated area will include Rio Chama (river) and a 100 yard buffer (exempt from closure for fishing access)
- Designated area will include river only access points
