# License Revocations

**Before you today are five separate groups of individuals subject to revocations for your approval.**

- **Group 1** - Revocation of an Individual's Guide/Outfitter Registration.
- **Group 2** - Revocation of an Individual who has had a hearing, and has submitted a written exception to the Hearing Officer's recommendation.
- **Group 3** - Revocation of Individuals who have had a hearing, and are not contesting the Hearing Officer's recommendation.
- **Group 4** - Revocation of individuals subject to revocation who have entered into a stipulated agreement.
- **Group 5** - Suspension of individuals that are subject to the Parental Responsibility Act (PRA).



# Group 1 - Revocation of an individual's Guide/ Outfitter Registration

- The Department has presented one individual that meets the established criteria for revocation of his Guide/Outfitter Registration privileges, having accumulated 20 or more misconduct points in a 3 year period.
- He was served with a Notice of Contemplated Action and declined to have a hearing. The Department is recommending that his Guide/Outfitter Registration privileges be revoked for three years.



## Group 2 - Revocation of 1 individual who has submitted a written exception to the Hearing Officer's Recommendation

- The Department has presented one individual that meets the established criteria for the revocation of his hunting, fishing and trapping license privileges.
- He was served with a Notice of Contemplated Action and requested a hearing. The Hearing Officer is recommending that his privileges be revoked for three years.
- He has submitted a written exception to this recommendation, for your consideration.



## Group 3 - Revocation of 5 individuals who are not contesting the Hearing Officers' Recommendations

- The Department has presented a list of 5 individuals that meet the established criteria for the revocation of their for hunting, fishing and trapping license privileges.
- Each was served with a Notice of Contemplated Action and requested a hearing. The Hearing Officers' recommendations are provided.



## Group 4 – Revocation of 3 individuals with stipulated agreements

- In accordance with Commission Rule 19.31.2.13 C “Stipulated Agreements.” By signing the stipulated agreement the individual agrees with the terms set forth and they waive their right to a hearing and filing of a written exception.
- Three (3) individuals elected to enter into a Stipulated Agreement with the Department.
- These agreements have been approved by the Department and are presented to the Commission for consideration and approval.



## Group – 5: Revocation of 281 individuals due to the Parental Responsibility Act (PRA)

- 281 obligors that the Human Services Department reported as being out of compliance with PRA in June and July.
- The Commission is required to suspend all license privileges for non-compliant obligors until they return into compliance.
