

Agenda Item 8 Hunting and Fishing License Revocation

License Revocations

Before you today are three separate groups of individuals subject to revocations for your approval.

- **Group 1** – Reciprocal revocation of 13 individuals' license privileges under the Interstate wildlife Violators Compact.
- **Group 2** - Revocation of 5 Registered Outfitters and Guides who have accumulated 20 or more violation points, and/or 20 or more Misconduct Points in a 3 year time period, who are subject to the revocation of their Outfitter and Guide Registration privileges and their Hunting, Fishing, and Trapping License privileges. These individuals were served with a Notice of Contemplated Action and requested a hearing. The Hearing Officer's report and recommendations are presented. 2 of these individuals have submitted written exceptions for your consideration.
- **Group 3** - Suspension of individuals that are subject to the Parental Responsibility Act (PRA).

Group 1 – Reciprocal revocation of 13 Individuals' License privileges under the Interstate wildlife Violators Compact

- Eleven of these individuals were convicted of wildlife violations that, if they were in New Mexico, would have accrued at least 20 points, thus being subject to having their license privileges revoked.
- They all went through the original state's due process before having their privileges revoked.
- The recommended time period is determined by the end date of the original revocation.
- Two of these individuals failed to appear in court, or to comply with the conditions of a wildlife citation. Under the Compact, member states suspend their license privileges until they are in compliance with the original citation.



Group 2 - Revocation of 5 Registered Outfitters and Guides

- The Department has presented a list of 5 individuals that meet the established criteria for the revocation of their Outfitting and Guiding Registrations and their hunting, fishing and trapping license privileges.
- Each requested a hearing. The Hearing Officer's reports and recommendations are provided.
- 2 of these individuals have submitted written exceptions for your consideration.



Revocation of Outfitting and Guiding Registration privileges

- In accordance with 19.31.2 NMAC, if a registered Outfitter or Guide accumulates 20 or more Violation Points in a three year period, they are subject to the revocation of their Outfitter/Guide Registration privileges, and their hunting, fishing, and trapping license privileges.
- Additionally, in accordance with 19.30.8 NMAC, Outfitters and Guides are held to a Code of Conduct. If a registered Outfitter or Guide accumulates 20 or more Misconduct Points in a three year period, they are subject to the revocation of their Outfitter/Guide Registration privileges.



Group 3 - Revocation of 111 individuals due to the Parental Responsibility Act (PRA)

- 111 obligors that the Human Services Department reported as being out of compliance with PRA in August and September
- The Commission is required to suspend all license privileges for non-compliant obligors until they return into compliance.
