• Three day notice for SPECIAL meetings

• 24 hour notice for EMERGENCY meetings

- Available at least 72 hours before REGULAR meetings
- Available at least 72 hours before SPECIAL meetings
- Available at least 24 hours before EMERGENCY meetings
