Least Shrew Habitat & Habits

- Widespread.
- In NM, inhabits various grassland and wetland plant communities.
- Insectivorous & primarily nocturnal.



Smallest mammal in New Mexico (4 grams).

Least Shrew Listing Background

- Not recorded in NM until 1981.


- Listed as threatened under WCA in 1985.

 No focused field work was done prior to listing. Known from only 3 sites.

Least Shrew Recovery Goal & Plan Contents

Plan Goal:

- To ensure the long-term persistence of robust, representative, and secure populations of Least Shrew in New Mexico's High Plains and Pecos River Valley such that they no longer require protection under the Wildlife Conservation Act and may be delisted.

Plan Contents:

Natural history summary
Historic and current distribution and abundance
Threats to persistence
Recovery objectives, criteria & tasks.
