19.31.3 NMAC

NMAC 19.31.3.11 (F) specifies that nonprofit organizations must demonstrate their history and ability to promote hunting, fishing and trapping in New Mexico to be approved by the Commission to receive donated hunting licenses for transfer to eligible recipients (youth hunters, resident veterans and resident first responders).



License Donation Procedure

- All donation requests must be received in writing
- The Department shall maintain a list of qualifying non-profit organizations, which shall be ranked in order based on Commission approval date. If multiple non-profits are approved on the same date, they shall be listed alphabetically and added to the bottom of the list
- Donated opportunities will be provided to the next non-profit organization on the list.
- Non-profit organizations will be required to provide documentation proving recipient's eligibility, and must provide an eligible recipient within a reasonable timeframe
- License will be transferred once verification of eligibility and other licensing requirements are met



Qualifying Non-Profit Organization

The following organization has provided the Department with documentation of their nonprofit status and documentation demonstrating their history and ability to promote hunting, fishing and trapping in New Mexico:
