Hunting and Fishing License Revocation

License Revocation

- The Department has presented you with a list of individuals that meet the established criteria for revocation or suspension of their hunting, fishing and trapping license privileges.



Field Operations Division

Wildlife Violators Compact

- The Department has presented you with a list of 2 individuals that meet the established criteria for reciprocal revocation of violators under the Wildlife Violators Compact, along with the Hearing Officers' reports and recommendations, and a written exception to that recommendation presented by one of those individuals.



Field Operations Division

License Revocation

- The Department has presented you with a list of 29 individuals who have accumulated 20 or more violation points in a 3 year period. In accordance with sections 17-1-14 and 17-3-34 NMSA, and Commission rule 19.31.2 NMAC these individuals are subject to having their hunting, fishing, and trapping license privileges revoked by the Commission for a definite period of time.



License Revocation

- Each of these individuals has been served with a Notice of Contemplated Action, and been offered the opportunity for a hearing to rebut or explain the violation points that they have accumulated. The listed individuals did not request a hearing, and the list contains the Department's recommendation for revocation and time period, in accordance with rule.



Parental Responsibility Act

- 295 obligors that the Human Services Department reported as being out of compliance in June and July.
- The Commission is required to suspend all license privileges for non-compliant obligors until they return into compliance.
