Non-Profit Organizations seeking approval to accept donated hunting licenses



19.31.3 NMAC

NMAC 19.31.3.11 (F) specifies that nonprofit organizations must demonstrate their history and ability to promote hunting, fishing and trapping in New Mexico to be approved by the Commission to receive donated hunting licenses for transfer to eligible recipients.

License Donation Procedure

- All donation requests must be in writing
- Department shall maintain a list of qualifying non-profit organizations
 - List shall be ranked in order, based on approval date
 - If multiple non-profits are approved on the same date, they shall be listed alphabetically and added to the bottom of the list
- Donated opportunities will be provided to the next nonprofit organization on the list
- Non-profit organizations will be required to provide documentation proving recipient's eligibility
- License will be transferred once verification of eligibility and other licensing requirements are met
