Background

Regulated Shooting Preserve Act

Sections 17-3-35 through 17-3-42, NMSA 1978

- The State Game Commission may issue licenses authorizing the establishment and operation of regulated propagated game bird shooting preserves on private lands when in the judgment of the commission, such areas will not conflict with any reasonable prior interest.

Rancho de Chavez Shooting Preserve

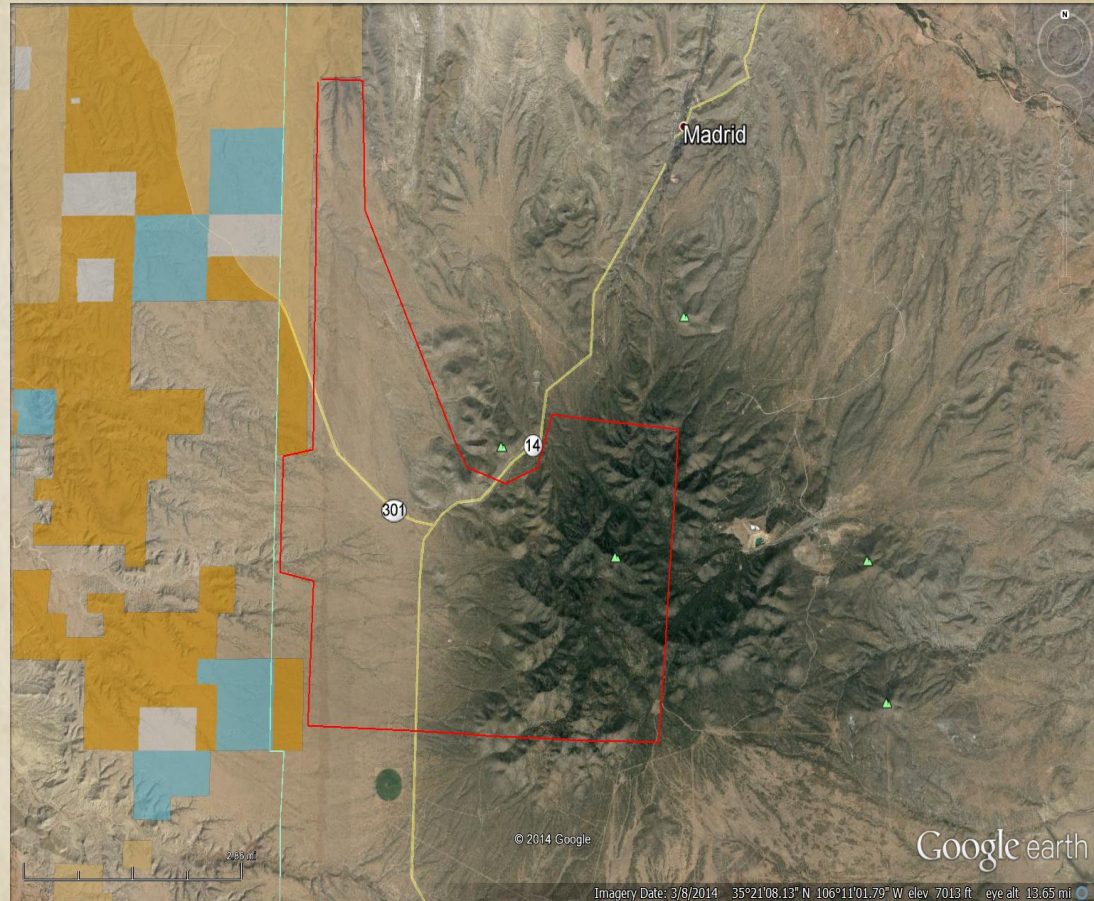
- Owner Steve Chavez plans on releasing propagated:
 - Pheasants
 - Chukar
 - Bobwhite & Scaled Quail
- Game species that occur naturally on the property
 - Mule Deer, Dove, and Small furbearers.

Rancho de Chavez Shooting Preserve

- Rancho de Chavez is located about 3 miles south of Madrid, NM in Santa Fe County. Part of the property encompasses part of the Ortiz Mountain Range.
- The proposed shooting preserve would consist of approximately 12,000 contiguous deeded acres.



Rancho de Chavez Shooting Preserve

- Conservation Officers have inspected and found the property to be suitable temporary holding habitat for propagated game birds.
- No adjoining landowners contacted expressed any objection to the shooting preserve.
