License Revocations



License Revocations

Before you today are three separate groups of individuals subject to revocations for your approval.

- Group 1 Revocation of 2 Registered Outfitters and Guides who have accumulated 20 or more Misconduct Points in a 3 year time period, who are subject to the revocation of their Outfitter and Guide Registration privileges. These individuals were served with a Notice of Contemplated Action and requested a hearing. The Hearing Officer's report and recommendations are presented. 1 of these individuals has submitted a written exception for your consideration.
- Group 2 Revocation of 1 Registered Outfitter or Guide who has accumulated 20 or more Misconduct Points in a 3 year time period, who is subject to the revocation of his Outfitter and Guide Registration privileges. This individual was served with a Notice of Contemplated Action and did not request a hearing. The Department is recommending a 5 year revocation due to this outfitter having been previously revoked by the Commission.
- Group 3 Suspension of individuals that are subject to the Parental Responsibility Act (PRA).



Revocation of Outfitting and Guiding Registration privileges

- In accordance with 19.30.8 NMAC, Outfitters and Guides are held to a Code of Conduct.
- If a registered Outfitter or Guide accumulates 20 or more Misconduct Points in a three year period, they are subject to the revocation of their Outfitter/Guide Registration privileges.



Group 1 - Revocation of 2 Registered Outfitters and Guides

- Gerald Blake is a registered outfitter. He has accumulated 70 misconduct points in a three year period. He was served a Notice of Contemplated Action advising him that he was subject having his outfitter and guide registration privileges revoked
- Mr. Blake requested a hearing. The Hearing Officer's reports and recommendations are provided.
- Mr. Blake has submitted a written exception for your consideration.



 "Move to accept the Hearing Officer's recommendation, and revoke Gerald Blake's Outfitter and Guide Registration privileges for a period of three years."



Group 1 - Revocation of 2 Registered Outfitters and Guides

- Eddie Pacheco is a registered outfitter. He has accumulated 50 misconduct points in a three year period. He was served a Notice of Contemplated Action advising him that he was subject having his outfitter and guide registration privileges revoked
- Mr. Pacheco requested a hearing. The Hearing Officer's reports and recommendations are provided.



 "Move to accept the Hearing Officer's recommendation, and revoke Eddie Pacheco's Outfitter and Guide Registration privileges for a period of three years."



Group 2 - Revocation of 1 Registered Outfitter and Guide

- John Rolston is a registered outfitter. He has accumulated 60 misconduct points in a three year period.
- Mr. Rolston was served a Notice of Contemplated Action advising him that he was subject having his outfitter and guide registration privileges revoked. He did not request a hearing.
- In 2010, Mr. Rolston's privileges were previously revoked by the Commission. In accordance with 19.31.2.8 D. (2) NMAC, the Department is recommending that Mr. Rolston's outfitting and guiding registration privileges be revoked for a period of 5 years.



 "Move to accept the Department's recommendation, and revoke John Rolston's Outfitter and Guide Registration privileges for a period of five years."



Group 3 - Revocation of individuals due to the Parental Responsibility Act (PRA)

- 267 obligors that the Human Services Department reported as being out of compliance with PRA in August and September
- The Commission is required to suspend all license privileges for non-compliant obligors until they return into compliance.



 "Move to authorize the Department to administer these suspensions on behalf of the Commission, including the issuance and service of a Notice of Contemplated Action to each individual listed that is out of compliance with the Parental Responsibility Act."
