Potential Amendments: Javelina (19.31.21 NMAC)

- **Statewide (except GMUs 19, 23-28) javelina hunts are undersubscribed by ~43-83%**
- **Recommend offering Statewide (excluding GMUs 19, 23-28) hunts over the counter**
- **Allow deer and elk hunter that possess OTC javelina license to hunt javelina during deer or elk hunt**

Javelina youth hunting opportunity

- **Presently, Youth Only hunt code allows statewide hunting**
- **Recommend increasing youth draw hunt numbers from 100 to 150**
- **Allow youth hunters that drew a youth javelina license to hunt javelina during deer or elk hunts.**
