
# Commission Appointments of Citizen Advisors to the Habitat Stamp Program

## Overview of the Habitat Stamp Program

- \$5 "Habitat Stamp" purchase required for hunters, anglers, and trappers who recreate on Bureau of Land Management (BLM) or USDA Forest Service (USFS) lands in New Mexico.
- The Habitat Stamp Program is a collaborative process for wildlife and habitat management between the NMDGF, BLM, USFS, and the public through Commission appointed Citizen Advisory Committees.

### Citizen Advisory Committees



- 35 Committee Members
  Appointed by the State
  Game Commission
- Serve 3-year terms
- 5 committees statewide
- 7 committee members:
  - 5 Representing Sportsmen/ Sportswomen
  - 1 Representing Nonsporting Conservation
  - 1 Representing Public Land Permittees / Lessees

## Appointment Process for Citizen Advisory Committees

- Solicitations for applicants were implemented through the NMDGF website, NMDGF e-mail distribution lists, NMDGF news release, The Wildlife Society NM Section e-mail list, conservation organization email lists, social media, and word-of-mouth.
- 98 applications were received.
- A Sub-Committee of the Commission was appointed to review applications and provide recommendations.
