

2017 Harvest Data



- Statewide 36,704 licenses sold/converted
- 81% of hunters reported
- 39% successful in harvesting
- Estimated statewide harvest
 - Bulls = 8,367, Cows = 6,021
- Satisfaction rating = 3.66

Proposed Changes

- Adjust seasons for calendar dates
- Adjust draw license numbers based on biological data & management goals
- COER boundary adjustments based on biological data
- Create some new opportunities



NW Area

- GMU 2 (San Juan Herd): Stable to slightly increasing (34:100:36)
 - Possibly increase hunts (harvest & success increasing in recent years)
 - Consider removing from COER
 - Remove from Quality designation
- **GMU 9 (Mt. Taylor Herd)**: Declining (25:100:16)
 - Eliminate all cow hunts, further reduce bull licenses
 - Calf:Cow ratios still very low
 - COER: Possibly expand to east
- GMUs 4, 5B, 50, 51, 52 (Northcentral Herd): Stable to slightly increasing (38:100:40)
 - Possible late season hunt in GMU 50
- GMUs 6A-C, 7 (Jemez Herd): Stable (33:100:32)
 - Valles Caldera (GMU 6B): Eliminate MI hunts & coordinate with VCNP

SW Area

- GMU 13 (Datil Herd): Stable to slightly increasing (33:100:32)
 - COER: Possibly extend boundary
- **GMUs 15, 16A-E (Greater Gila Herd)**: Stable to slightly increasing (34:100:33)
 - No Changes
- <u>GMU 17 (San Mateo-Magdalena Herd)</u>: Stable to slightly increasing (49:100:41)
 - COER: Possibly extend boundary
- GMUs 21A-B, 23, 24 (Lesser Gila Herd): Stable to slightly increasing (42:100:38*)
 - Possibly create late season archery hunts (GMUs 21, 23)
 - Considering combining 21A & 21B; increase MB
 - COER: Possibly expand boundary in GMU 21



SE Area

- GMU 34 (Sacramento Herd): Increasing (49:100:49)
 - Increase draw licenses (particularly female)
 - Consider changing MB hunts to ES
 - COER: Possibly modify boundary
- GMU 36 (Ruidoso Herd): Stable to slightly increasing (71:100:52)
 - · Consider increasing bull licenses (all weapon types) based on population data
 - COER: Possibly adjust boundary



NE Area

- **GMU 45 (Pecos Herd)**: Stable (27:100:27)
 - COER: Possibly extend boundary
- **GMU 48 (Whites Peak Herd)**: Stable (32:100:44)
 - Consider moving Dec MB hunt to Oct
- **GMU 49 (Penasco Herd)**: Stable (28:100:30)
 - No Changes
- GMU 53 (Ute-Midnite-San Cristobal Herd): Stable (28:100:30)
 - No Changes

Other items

Establishing COER

- GMU 12: Consider making a COER GMU
- GMU 37: Possibly move some southern portions into COER

Special management zone possibilities

• GMUs 46, 54, 55

License adjustments

- Valle Vidal: separate YO and adult hunts
- GMU 56, 57: increase licenses (possibly create new hunt period)
- GMU 42/47/59: combine and create a public hunt

Other

- Combine Colin Neblett north & south
- Establish hunt in GMU 14
- Develop limited hunt on WSMR
- Youth Encouragement hunts: reduce 14 days limited to residents
- Standardize some hunt dates
