
Update on Shooting Range Development in New Mexico







Youth Archery Range Albuquerque Shooting Range Park



- June 30: Invitation to Bid drafted
- Currently waiting for City of Albuquerque to return MOU

NEXT STEPS: Complete MOU and contract construction.

COMPLETION TARGET: February 2016



Clovis Shooting Complex



- Sept. 22: Encumbrance approved for conceptual design
- Oct. 30: Expected completion date for design

NEXT STEPS: Present final design to City Commission for approval.

COMPLETION TARGET: May 2016



Cibola County Shooting Range

- July 16: Met with BLM to review R&PP steps, responsibilities
- Aug. 17: Archaeology survey started, completed Sept. 1
- Aug. 25: BLM started process for Federal Register notice
- Sept. 10: Contacted grazing leasee with intent to purchase lease
- Sept. 22: Encumbrance approved for plan of development

NEXT STEPS: Complete archaeology survey report, Plan of Development, NEPA, Mineral survey, Federal Register published, Appraisal, Cadastral Survey, Construction



COMPLETION TARGET: September 2016



FEDERAL TIMELINE

- Sept. 4 Sept 3, 2017: Letter to current grazing permittee sent out to serve as two-year notification to reduce grazing acres.
- Oct. 1: Land Description Review by Cadastral Survey (required for Federal Register Notice)
- Oct. 9: Federal Register Notice review by State
 Office and Washington Office for review
- Dec. 1: Federal Register Notice published
- Jan. 15, 2016: Comment period ends provided Federal Register Notice is published on 12/1/15
- Feb. 1, 2016: End of Governor's review period. Classification of the land will become effective provided no adverse comments are received



FEDERAL TIMELINE

- Feb. 15, 2016: T & E Survey, Mineral Potential Report
- Mar. 15, 2016: Cadastral Survey
- Apr. 1, 2016: NEPA (Environmental Assessment)
- May 15, 2016: Environmental Site Assessment
 4-6 month process. Valid for 6 months.
- May 30, 2016: Appraisal Valid for 12 months and will not be requested until the comment period is closed.
- June 5, 2016: Issue decision offering the applicant a lease with a limited reversionary provision and option to purchase
- July 2016: Construction Begins



Santa Fe Shooting Range

- June 19: Cultural survey completed
- August 7: Santa Fe County provided Lidar Survey data
- August 17: Biological Evaluation and Cultural Resources Inventory draft reports provided to NMDGF
- August 26: Coordinated with Santa Fe County for a range clean-up day, October 3



NEXT STEPS: R&PP expected completion date - April 29, 2016
