

Citizen Advisory Committees



- 35 Committee Members
 Appointed by the State
 Game Commission
- Serve 3-year terms
- All current appointments expire December 31, 2016
- 5 committees statewide
- 7 committee members:
 - 5 Representing Sportsmen/Sportswomen
 - 1 Representing Nonsporting Conservation
 - 1 Representing Public Land Permittees / Lessees

Role of the Citizen Advisory Committees

- Provide input and advice on project proposals, planning documents, and program direction.
- Prioritize project proposals for funding with Habitat Stamp funds.
- Provide citizen oversight and report Habitat Stamp Program activities back to peers and constituents.
- Provide representation, but promote cooperation.

Appointment Process for Citizen Advisory Committees

- Solicitations for potential applicants to serve on a Citizen Advisory Committee will be implemented through the Department's website, e-mail distribution lists, Department news release(s), and word-of-mouth.
- Applications will be compiled by Department staff.
 - Last appointment cycle a Sub-Committee of the Commission was appointed to review and evaluate all applications in coordination with Department staff.
- Full Commission acts on the recommended appointments.
- Final appointments will be filed with the Governor's Office and Department of Finance and Administration Secretary
