



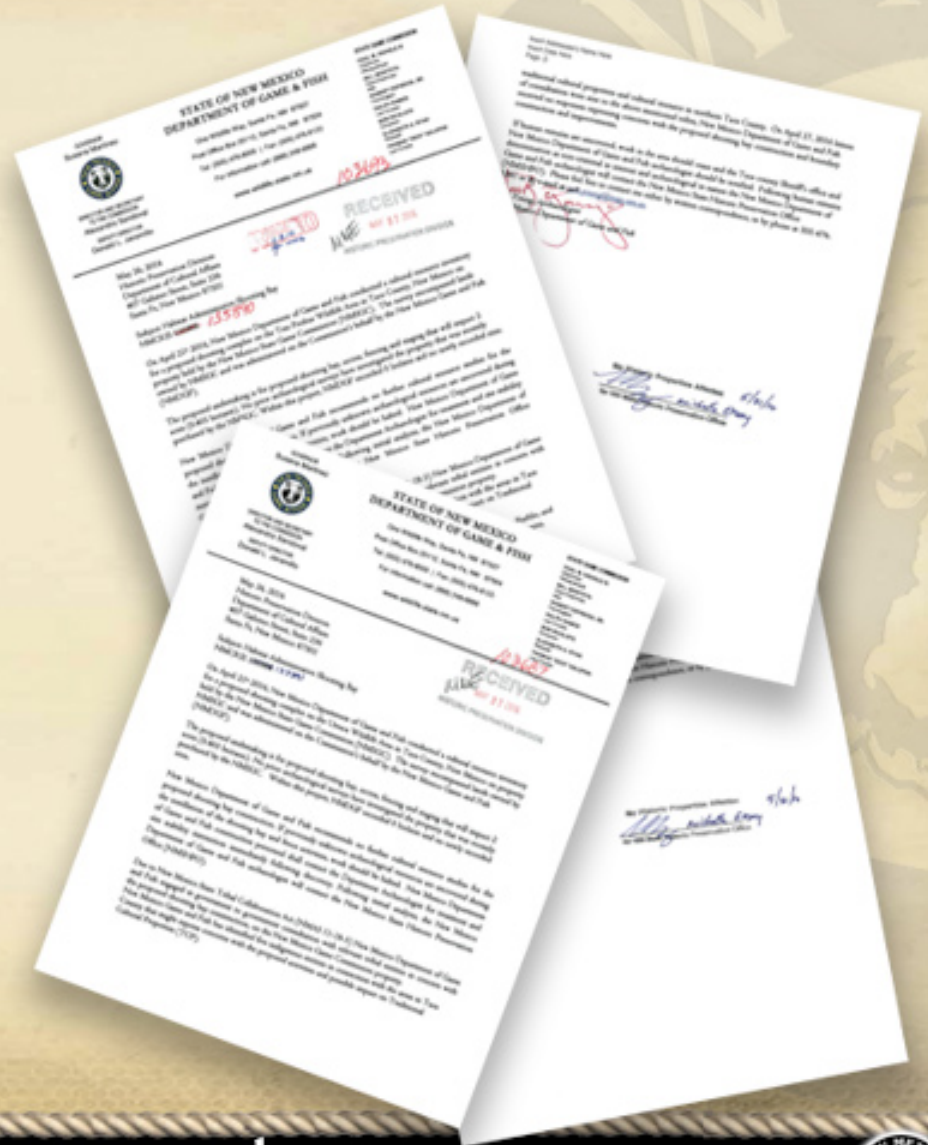

- **New Mexico State Historic Preservation Office (NMSPHO) approval received June 6, 2016**



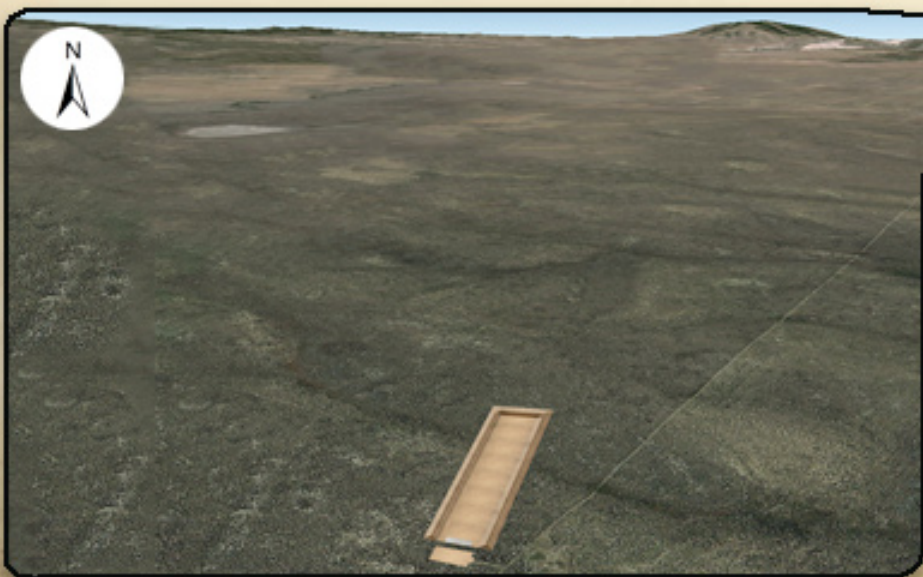


*Future Site of

Sage Grouse Restoration



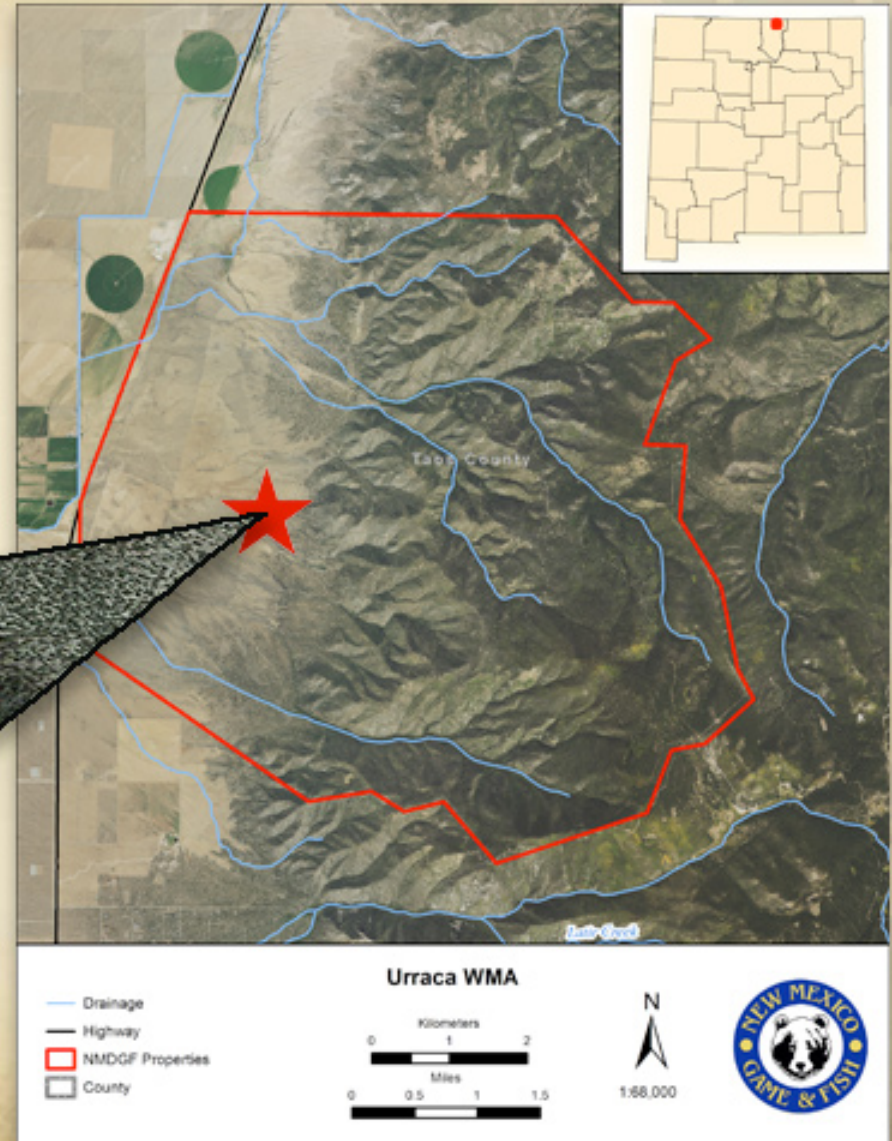


*Future Site of

Urraca Wildlife Area

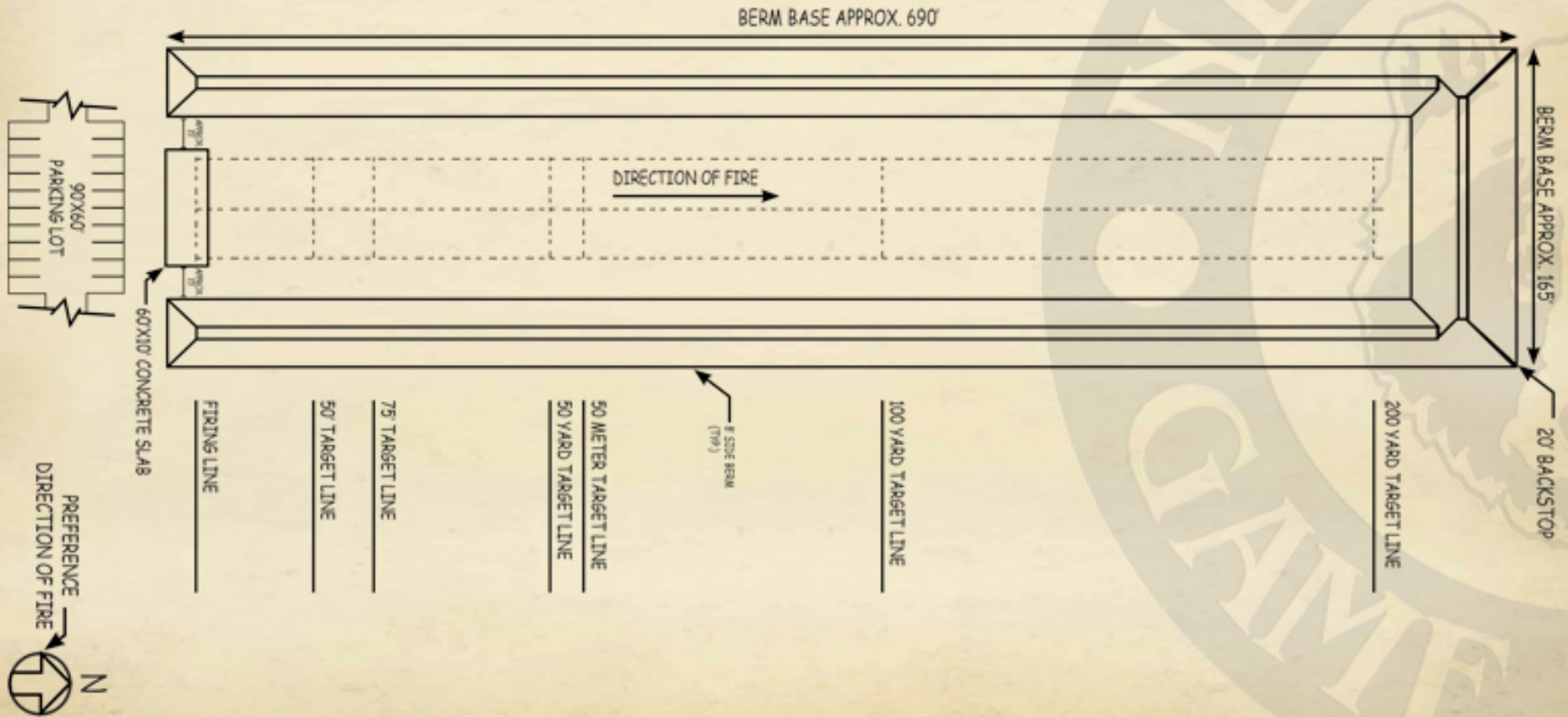
- 12.5 miles North of Questa

Wintering Elk

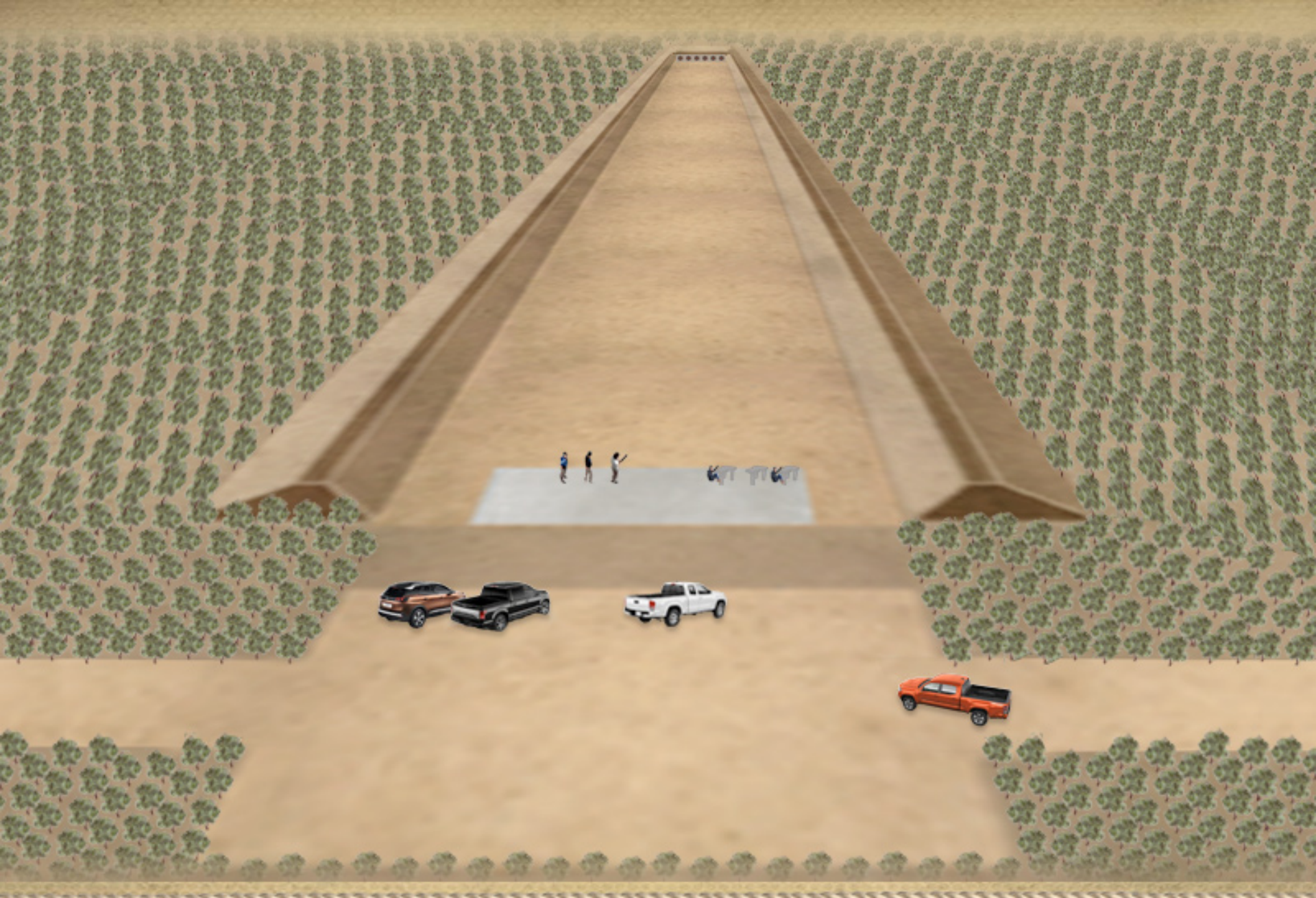




NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND FISH
