Fisheries Rule Proposals

- Clarify definition of "Barbless lure or fly" consistent with Manner and Method Definition
- Special Trout Water Designation Jack's Creek, Rio Chiquito, and Rio San Antonio (near Lagunitas Lakes)
 - Catch and Release for Rio Grande Cutthroat Trout
 - Unlimited harvest for non-native trout
 - Tackle limited to barbless lures or flies
- Remove Santa Cruz, Bonito, Monastery, and Springer Lakes reference for ice fishing prohibition
- Add Definition of Special Trout Water





Manner and Method Proposals



- Clarify definition of "Barbless lure or fly" – consistent with Fisheries Rule Definition
- Remove Santa Cruz, Bonito, and Springer Lakes reference for ice fishing prohibition
- Prohibit using "bait fish" within BLM Overflow Wetlands
- Electric Trolling Motors at Jackson Lake WMA
- Director's authority to suspend angling limits, methods, and size limits or to close a water
 - Six Months










- STW 222,000 angler days/year
