



Summary of Proposed Changes to 19.30.3.11

- Amend eligibility verification requirements for the mobility impaired provision in 19.31.3.11 NMAC.
- H. Mobility-impaired (MI) deer, elk, oryx, or pronghorn license qualifications: To hold a mobility impaired deer, elk, oryx, or pronghorn license, a person must submit verifiable documentation on the proper department form that is attested to by a certified medical physician that the individual has a permanent mobility restriction which limits their activity to a walker, wheelchair, or crutches; or one or more permanent disabilities or conditions which substantially limit the individual's ability to walk; and then obtain permanent department approval for MI hunt eligibility. ~~Every person qualified as MI shall have their card/eligibility expire 48 months from the issuance date and must resubmit their application and obtain department approval as required above prior to being eligible to apply for any MI hunt.~~
- The Department requests the effective date of the proposed rule is June 24, 2026 after the rule is published in the State Registrar.
