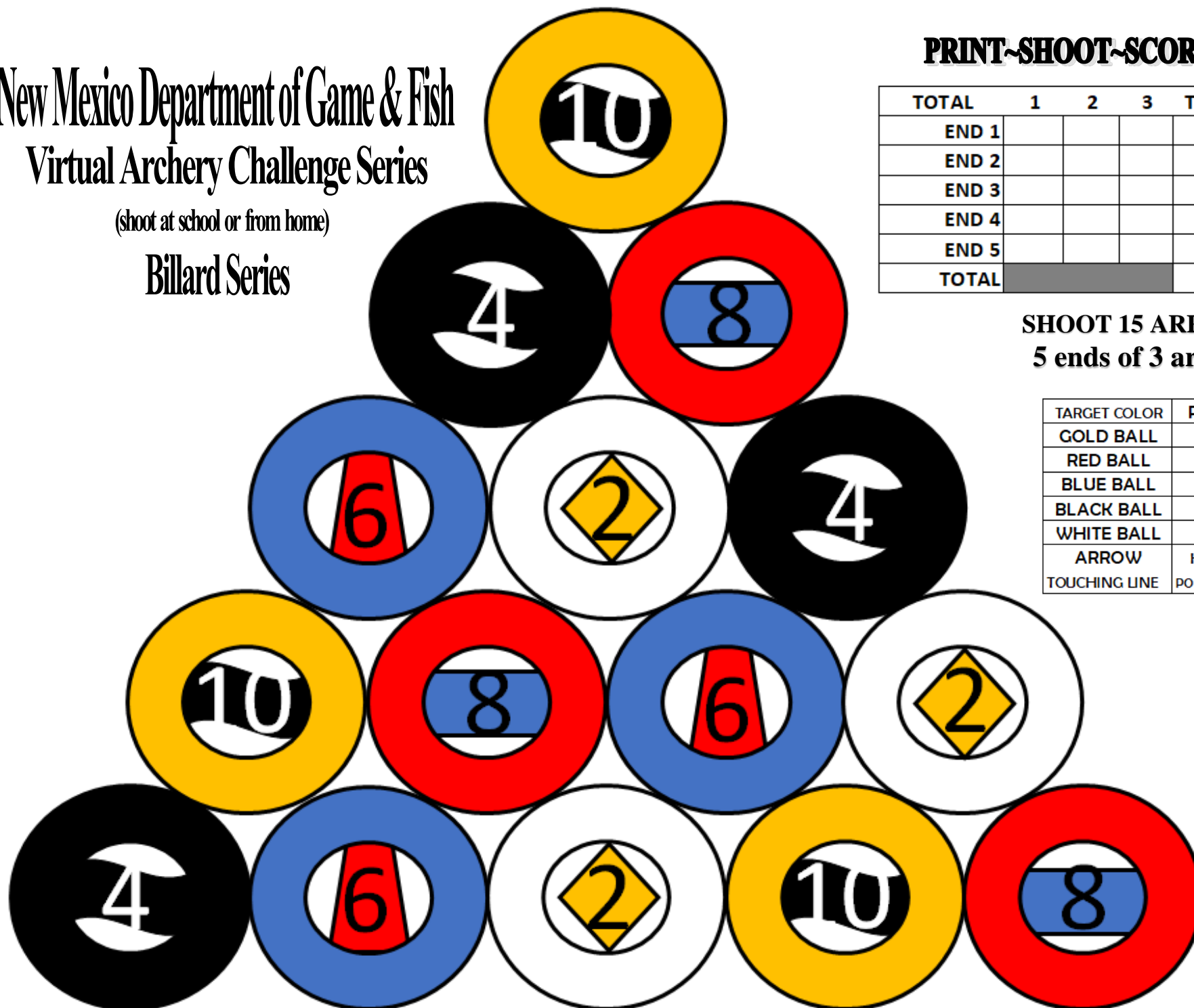

April Challenge Series Billard Series

1. SAFETY

- a. Follow all NM Virtual Archery Challenge Series Safety Protocols.
- b. Follow all State and Local Covid-19 Health Orders (<https://cv.nmhealth.org/>).

2. DATES

Shoot and submit scores by – April 30TH, 2021.

3. HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- a. Print off the target face on 8.5" X 11" computer paper.
- b. Tape or pin to your own target.
- c. Mark off shooting distance to target.
 - i. Elementary (1st – 5th): 6-8 yards
 - ii. Middle School (6th – 8th): 8-10 yards
 - iii. High School (9th – 12th): 10-12 yards
- d. Choose your bow type:
 - (1) NASP Genesis bow
 - (2) Compound bow w/sight
 - (3) Traditional (longbow or recurve) – no sight
 - (4) Olympic Recurve
- e. Shoot 15 arrows total, 5 ends of 3 arrows.

4. SCORING CONSISTS OF: 10 points max per arrow – 150 maximum points per challenge

- a. An arrow touching a gold ball = 10 PTS.
- b. An arrow touching a red ball = 8 PTS.
- c. An arrow touching a blue ball = 6 PTS.
- d. An arrow touching a black ball = 4 PTS.
- e. An arrow touching a white ball = 2 PTS.
- f. Arrows touching the line earn the higher point value.

5. SUBMIT SCORES

- a. Shoot the challenge as many times as you want.
- b. Submit your score (by the challenge deadline) – April 30TH, 2021.
- c. Submit score on this website: www.wildlife.state.nm.us/education/virtual-archery-challenge-series/ or directly to: <https://forms.gle/ARUKJasHXbBNpCbf7>.
- d. Ranking will be made and the top scorers will be named at the end of each monthly challenge on the NMDGF website.
- e. Print your challenge certificate from the NMDGF website: www.wildlife.state.nm.us/education/virtual-archery-challenge-series/.
- f. Successfully complete 5 of the 7 monthly challenges to earn a challenge coin.
