
10.05.010 Local authority authorization.

A person may operate an off-highway motor vehicle, as defined in Section 66-3-1001.1 NMSA, as it appears now or may be amended, on paved streets or highways owned by the city of Clovis, subject to the following conditions:

- A. The vehicle has one or more headlights and one or more taillights that comply with the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Act;
- B. The vehicle has brakes, mirrors and mufflers;
- C. The operator has valid driver's licenses or permits as required under the Motor Vehicle Code and off-highway motor vehicle safety permits as required under the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Act;
- D. The operator is insured in compliance with the provisions of the Mandatory Financial Responsibility Act;
- E. The operator of the vehicle is using eye protection that complies with the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Act; and
- F. If the operator is under eighteen years of age, the operator is wearing a safety helmet that complies with the Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Act.
