

OPEN GATE PROGRAM INFORMATION Access for Hunters, Anglers, and Trappers

What is the Open Gate Program?

• A statewide program operated by New Mexico Department of Game and Fish that leases private land for public hunting, angling, trapping, and right-of-way access opportunities.



 Through Open Gate, participating landowners provide legal access to sportsmen and sportswomen, while the state provides monetary incentives, liability protection, and increased patrolling efforts by law enforcement.

What are the benefits to sportsmen and sportswomen?

- Provides hunting, fishing, and/or trapping opportunities on private lands enrolled in the program.
- Improves access to landlocked public lands.
- Increases access opportunities at no additional cost to sportsmen and women.
- Private land access without written permission.

Important information to know:

- Access opportunities are available to properly licensed sportspersons only.
- Property rules and regulations are posted at each property and are available online.
- The draw hunt system still applies to Open Gate properties that allow big game hunting.
- Open Gate property boundaries are available on *OnX Hunt*; however, road and gate access information may be incorrect. Follow the mapped routes and information on the Open Gate website or contact the Open Gate Program Coordinator if assistance is needed.
- Target practice, camping and other prohibited activities posted onsite are not permitted.
- Please Be Respectful and Courteous landowner participation is voluntary.
