

Rare Fishes of the Gila River in New Mexico

Headwater Chub *Gila nigra* State Endangered, Federal Candidate

Preferred Habitat - pools with hiding cover (boulders and woody debris).

Current NM Range – East, Middle, and West Forks of the Gila River.



Preferred Habitat – moderate to high velocity riffles with clean substrate.

Current NM Range – Portions of the Gila and San Francisco Rivers.

<u>Spikedace *Meda fulgida*</u> State Endangered, Federal Threatened

Preferred Habitat – open shallow runs with clean gravel and sand substrate.

Current NM Range – Portions of the Gila River
