Even Numbered Years are 30-Day or “Short” Sessions

- The New Mexico Constitution restricts matters discussed during 30-day sessions to:
 - Budget and fiscal matters
 - Items on the Governor’s “call”
 - Legislation vetoed in the previous session
- During a long session, legislators may introduce bills without restrictions.




Proposed Legislative Priorities

- Operating Budget Request (HB5/2)
- Capital Projects Requests
- Enhanced Penalties for Wildlife Violations



Enhanced Penalties

- House Bill 55 in 2013 Session
- Passed House Unanimously and Passed Both Senate Committees
- Requires Approval by Governor
