Total Acreage: 848 acres.

**Purchase:** Rio de los Pinos Wildlife Area was purchased in 1953 to provide fishing and recreational access.

**Description:** The Rio de los Pinos Wildlife Area contains 1.5 miles of river. The bottom land is covered in grassy meadows and cottonwoods.
