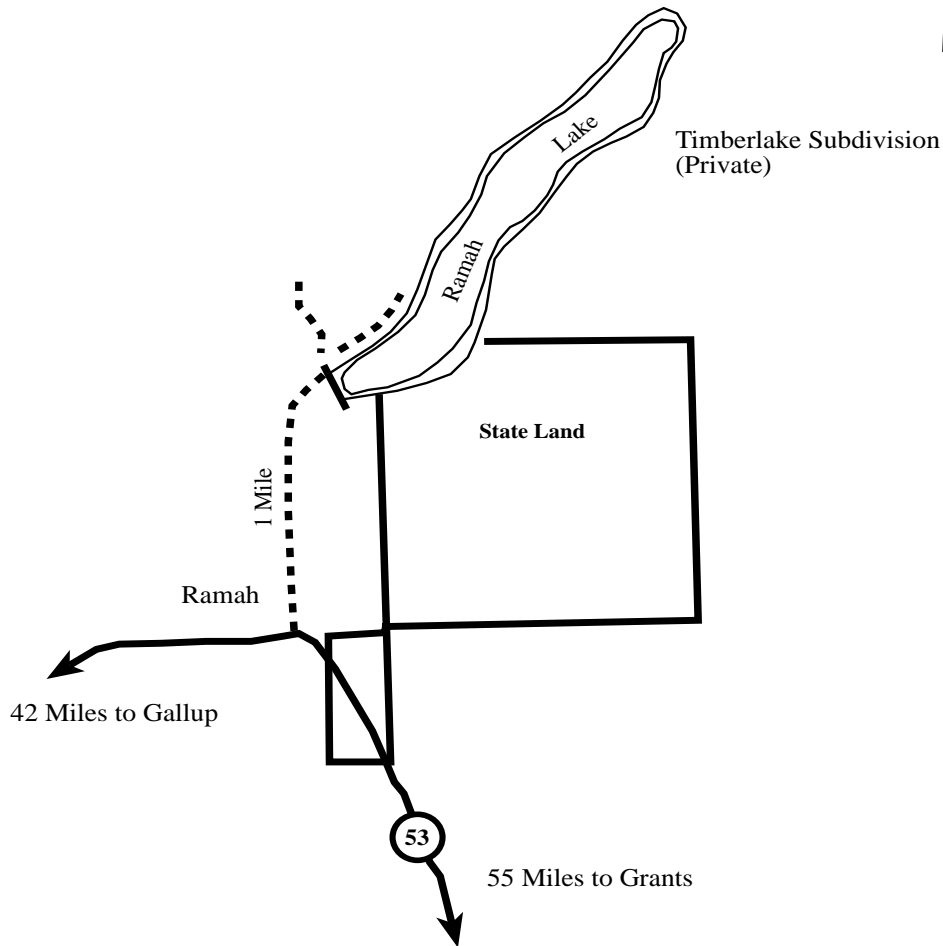
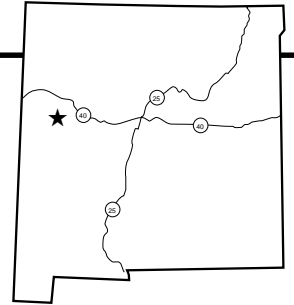




State Wildlife Areas

Ramah Lake



Glittering blue beneath rimrock cliffs, Ramah Lake contains both postcard scenery and rainbow trout beneath stands of pinon and ponderosa. The lake lies south of Gallup and Grants, and it was leased for public fishing in January 1988 by the State Game Commission from the Ramah Land and Irrigation Co.

Lake users should be mindful that some of the shoreline is private, and not included in the lease for public access.

The lake, set between sandstone walls, was created in 1902.
